There is also the new Preparation for Tertiary Success program which is specifically aimed at students who have not studied for a while or who want to refresh their skills and knowledge in areas such as academic writing, computers and maths before they commence a full higher degree program such as the Bachelor of Education.

Residents of the Tiwi Islands can take advantage of the study facilities on offer through Batchelor Institute at the main residential campus at Batchelor, 100 km south of Darwin and through the Darwin Study Annexe at Parap. Students also receive ongoing support with their studies from visiting lecturers and tutors when they return home to their communities between workshops.

To begin your studies in the 2nd semester this year students need to complete their enrolment processes by the middle of August. So act NOW and start your next learning journey at Batchelor Institute.

The 2011 Census of Population and Housing is fast approaching.



Soon, thousands of people from the Census Management Unit will help tell the story of their community through Census

You may have already seen some Census staff in their bright yellow shirts in the communities of Bathurst and Melville Islands.

They are in the communities making sure all the houses are on their maps.

In late July, teams will then return to interview families about where they live and the people at their house or dwelling.

In other areas like Wurankuwu, 4 Mile, Pirlangimpi and Milikapiti locals will see collectors with bright yellow bags dropping off their forms.

You will be able to complete Census from Monday 25 July.

It helps plan our future services and infrastructure: Things like roads, clinics and schools.

Billions of dollars in infrastructure spending is determined from Census so it's really important that everyone is counted.

That includes babies and visitors.

Information isn't shared with NT Police, housing, Centrelink or anyone like that so it's OK to tell Census teams about everyone in the house.

Everyone needs to be counted and to have a voice to tell our story.

So when you see the mob in yellow, say hello!

They are here to help your community.

A Territory Government initiative

New houses in your community

New houses will be built and other houses will be fixed up.

Territory Housing is responsible for deciding who lives in the new houses. If you want to live in a new house you will need to fill out an application.

Territory Housing will:

- assess applications based on need
- take advice from the community about social and cultural matters
- consider if the person can look after the house and pay rent

Priority will be given to people:



living in the most overcrowded conditions



who are living in a home that is in bad condition



with disabilities
