TITEB Money Management Workers and Langauge Literacy and Numeracy students are undertaking a Baking course with David from Charles Darwin University.

The course will be conducted over 4 weeks and students who complete will receive a Certificate I in Retail Baking.

These students will then be able to train other people in their communities to bake healthy nutritious bread, bread rolls and cakes using the commercial ovens TITEB has set up in the training centres on the Islands. TITEB will supply the ingredients and people will be able to drop into the centres and bake what they want and take it home to their families.



This program and the cooking program they are doing with Steve from CDU is being funded by the NT Government and are improving the outcomes from our Money Management Program funded by FaHCSIA and our Language Literacy and Numeracy Program funded by DEEWR. These programs are really making a difference to Tiwi Lives!
